Visual Arts Program

- Mr. Clodd introduced the Visual Arts program at UHS and highlighted the upcoming UHS 40th anniversary in 2025 at the beginning of the presentation.

 - 6 sections: 160 students
 - Core Program 2024/2025
 - 21 sections: 588 students
- Selection process

 - Online application closes November 30th (2024 dates tbd)
 - Auditions are held at UHS during exam week Late January TBD
 - Selection workshop format explained; demonstration by teachers; a uniform process Selection process also includes portfolio review and audition

Mr. Belmonte presented the upcoming family dashboard setup which will be introduced this week.
