Author's last name, initials. (Year of publication). Title of book. Place of publication: Publisher.

Book written by TWO AUTHORS

Parker, G., & Eyers, K. (2010). Navigating teenage depression. London, England: Routledge.

Author's last name, initials., & author's last name, initials. (Year of publication). *Title of book.* Place of publication: Publisher.

Book written by MORE THAN THREE AUTHORS

Stein, A. et al. (2208). *Kidney transplants explained: An Introduction to clinical medicine. New*York, NY: McGraw Hill.

First author listed + et al (which means "and others"). (Year of publication). *Title of book*. Place of publication: Publisher.

Book with an EDITOR

DeMott, A. (Ed.). (2008). What is the impact of cyberlife? Detroit, IL: Greenhaven.

Editor's last name, initials. (Ed.) (short for editor). (Year of publication). *Title of book*. Place of publication: Publisher.

Book with a CORPORATION, ASSOCIATION, INSTITUTION as author

Canadian Pharmacists Association. (2004). Guide to drugs in Canada. Toronto, ON: Dorling.

Name of Institution, Association, or Corporation. (Year of publication). *Title of book.* Place of publication: Publisher.

MAGAZINE article – with author

Kluger, J. (2011, March 28). Fear goes nuclear. Time, 35-38.

Author's last name, initial. (Date of publication). Title of Article. Name of Magazine, Range of pages.

MAGAZINE article – no author

Safer schools. (2013, September). Canadian Family, 55.

Title of article. (Date of publication). Name of Magazine, Page number.

Encyclopedia

Berg, E.L. (2004). Kindergarten. In *Encyclopedia of children and childhood* (Vol. 2, pp.524-525). New York, NY: Macmillian.

Author's last name, initials. (Date of publication). Title of article. In *Name of Encyclopedia* (volume and page numbers). Place of publication: Publisher.

Picture

Adams, A. (1927). *Monolith, the face of Half Dome, Yosemite National Park* [photograph]. Art Institute, Chicago.

Artist/photographer's last name, initials. (Date work was created). *Title of painting/photograph* [descriptive label – i.e. painting/sculpture/photograph]. Name and place of institution that houses the work.

NOTE: Map/Chart

Citation for a map/chart/graph/table **should appear below the item in the text** rather than placed in the Reference List.
