## Message from our Trustee

As we near the end of the school year, I want to thank you for all that you do to strengthen our schools and communities. This is a good time to celebrate your child's achievements over the past year.

One of our goals in the <u>Trustees' Multi-Year Plan</u> is to "continuously increase student achievement and well-being through a culture and caring and learning." That includes a culture that emphasizes engagement and positive relationships among all the members of the school community – students, staff members, families and community members.

You, as parents/guardians, are our most important partners when it comes to education. The support you have provided to your child throughout this past school year will help to strengthen our schools and make a difference to your child's learning.

# Early Dismissal in Elementary Schools Thursday, June 29th, 2017

All schools in the York Region District School Board are committed to improving student achievement and well-being. On **Thursday**, **June 29**, **2017**, an early release day will take place to allow elementary teachers and support staff to take part in meetings during the afternoon of that day. These meetings will allow for school staff to engage in culminating activities regarding the review and revision of the School's Improvement Plan as well as year-end and transition activities that support student success.

As has been our practice in the past, students will attend school during the morning of Thursday, June 29, 2017 only. Students will be dismissed early that day at **11:30am**. Arrangements will be made to ensure that students who are normally bused to and from school will receive transportation at this time. Parents/guardians whose children attend after school child care should make appropriate arrangements to address this change in schedule.

# FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Since there are many changes that happen over the summer with families moving in and out of our neighbourhood, we cannot share who your child's teacher will be at this time. You will meet your child's teacher on the first day of school, Tuesday September 5th, 2017.

On the first day of school please arrive at school between 8:15 and 8:25am. Kindergarten students will be meeting their teachers in the Kindergarten play pens. Everyone will go to the tarmac area behind the school. Teachers will have signs indicating where to go. There will be a grade 1 area, a grade 2 area, etc. Teachers will read out the names of the children in their classes and get everyone organized and they will then proceed to their classrooms to begin their day.

Students should have a morning snack as well as a lunch for the first day of school.

## **CALLING ALL LIBRARY BOOKS!**

It's already almost that time again! All books need to be back in the library by <u>JUNE</u> <u>19.</u> No new books will be coming home after June 14. Pink notices with payment information will be sent home to students who have lost library books, as a reminder the book or payment for a lost/damaged book must be returned to school by the end of the year.

Please also check for any other materials that belong to the school - books, text-books, classroom materials etc.- you may return these items to the library as well, Ms. Puddy will return them to the proper location in the school.

Remember to keep reading in the summer! Markham Public Libraries run many different reading programs throughout the summer, including free drop in programs and a reading buddy program.


