PICK UP AND DROP OFF SAFETY AT UMPS

- We strongly encourage UMPS students to walk to and from school
- **Parking lot** entry is only for Kindergarten Parents (please make sure you have a yellow entry pass). There is no parking on school property unless there is a meeting planned or if you have school business to attend to
- **Parking lot** is a loop where staff will meet you beside your car to help get your child out of their seat and bring them to their kindergarten enclosures
- At the end of the school day, please only park along the loop to pick up your Kindergarten child/ren. If you cannot find a spot along the loop, please keep going around the loop until you can find one.
- Two left lanes will be blocked with safety pylons at our front loop so that only one lane is operable
- **Front loop** is for kiss and ride where parents / guardian need to drive up along the inside curb lane as far up as the car in front of you. This will help to move traffic along South Unionville Ave.
- Please continue to signal and check your blind spot before proceeding into the exit lane once the drop off has been made


