The program consists of **two optional sessions**. The first five weeks are the sing along rehearsal weeks where children will learn how to sing and dance the production numbers and learn to emulate the different characters in the show. Session 1 is group oriented. Parents can choose to enroll for Session one only. For those looking to continue on and obtain a role in the show and take part in the performance of the musical at the theatre, they must enroll for the second session in addition to the first session.

Children cannot enroll for session 2 without first enrolling in Session 1 as Session 1 is a prerequisite to session 2)
