SCHOOL HOURS

Bell times: 9:10 a.m. and 3:40 p.m. Supervision begins at 8:55 a.m. each day.

Starting on Wednesday, September 6 we will follow a soft entry procedure for all students which means that students may enter the building and go straight to class starting at 8:55 a.m. There will be supervision in the Kindergarten classrooms and school hallways during this time, and at the Kiss and Ride from 8:55 a.m.- 9:10 a.m. *Please do not leave your children unsupervised on school property prior to this time.*

BUS TRANSPORTATION

School bus transportation starts on the first day for all students **except** Year 1 Kindergarten (JK). Please go to the <u>School Bus City website</u> to confirm your bus stop. On Tuesday, we will provide a bus tag to eligible students. The tag is for their afternoon route.

If there is a change in your child's transportation needs, please email the office (<u>viola.desmond.ps@yrdsb.ca</u>) so we can update our records.

A Google Form was sent to all families who have children eligible for school transportation. Kindly complete the form by Friday, September 1 at 9:00AM if your child will be riding the bus home from school.

	Please note, this does not include lunch time.	
	Year 1 students attend for the full day, starting on Wednesday, September 6	
	Year 2 (SK) students attend full day starting on Tuesday, September 5	
	Parents/Guardians bring their children to the Kindergarten play area gate located near the main entrance of the school.	
	An educator will direct the child into their classroom where they will be greeted by their second educator.	
	Parents are not permitted into the Kindergarten play area. Please do not congregate near the gate in order to allow all children to enter safely.	
Grades 1-8		
	French Immersion - will meet at the south west door near the basketball court	
	Grade 1, 2, 3 (Ms. Carson, Ms. Lombardi and Mr. Goldman) - will meet at the south east door near fence	
	Grade 3/4-8 (Ms. Khait, Ms. Bhimani, Ms. Ricciardi, Ms. Cogan, Ms. Gahiri, Ms. Rossi and Ms. Ages) - will meet at the west doors near the child care	
	Teachers will be standing outside with signs with their class code. French Immersion teachers will have orange signs. English program teachers will have blue signs.	
	Students will line up in front of their teachers. Once a teacher has all of their students, the class will enter the school. Parents, please do not congregate on the tarmac or near the doors as this makes it difficult for teachers to take attendance. We want to make sure the lineups and entry are safe for students and staff.	
Bus	All students who arrive by bus will be directed to their doors/teacher by school staff.	

*Any student who arrives late must go to the main entrance and ring the bell. Office staff will let the student in and direct them to their classroom.




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FIRST DAY PROCEDURES: DISMISSAL

Kindergarten	Dismissal from the Kindergarten play area. Parents need to wait outside the play area and staff will bring the children out. Please be patient on the first few days as dismissal takes time in order to safely dismiss our youngest learners.
French Immersion Dismissal	Students in Gr. 1 and Gr. 2 French Immersion will exit through the south west door near the basketball court
Classes: 1/2 -1 1/2 -2 2/3	Exit through the south east door near the parking lot This includes students from the following teacher's classes: Ms. Carson, Ms. Lombardi and Mr. Goldman
Classes: 3/4 - 8	Exit through the west door near the childcare. This includes students from the following teacher's classes: Ms. Khait, Ms. Bhimani, Ms. Ricciardi, Ms. Gahiri, Ms. Cogan, and Ms. Rossi
Bus	Students taking the bus will line up in the foyer by their bus route sign. Staff will take attendance as students get on the bus. Please remove old bus tags before school on Tuesday.

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On Wednesday, September 6 we will follow our "soft entry" procedures that were previously established. Students enter the building starting at 8:55am and go directly to their classrooms. Staff will be supervising throughout the school.

Students may be dropped off at the Kiss and Ride, or may enter through the doors shown on the map below. Please **do not enter the bus loop**. Also please note directional signs for our Kiss and Ride.

When using the Kiss and Ride, **do not leave your vehicle**. If you wish to walk your child to an entrance door, please park on the road.

Step 1: Register

Please go to the School Cash Online parent site: <u>https://yrdsb.schoolcashonline.com/</u>



Select the **"Register"** button

Enter your parent information to create an account. *For Security Reasons your password requires **8 characters**, **one uppercase** letter, **one lowercase** letter and a **number**.

Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be automatically forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and School Cash Online account. The confirmation link will open the School Cash Online site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.

Step 3: Find/Add Student

NOTE: Enter Student Number (not OEN) This step will connect your children to your account.
