1. Welcome – Daphna Romi / Steven Mayers:

- YouthSpeak was successful. L.H. Frechette hosting YouthSpeak on March 31, 2016 at 6pm.
- Parent's symposium on March 30th.
- Looking to secure more speakers and presenters for the next school year. Looking to stay with the Mental Health team.

2. Principal's Report – Sheri Epstein:

- Staffing and student numbers: Number of students will go up next year. 1255 currently, approx. 1340 for next year. School built for 1076. Ok to be 110-120% of capacity.
- Influx mostly Grade 9 next year 375 for Grade 9 class.
- Our population consist of 60% transfers, 40% local. Any transfer application in by end of February was automatically accepted. Beyond that there is no guarantee to accept transfers.
- Staffing numbers from board next week. Staffing formula is a combination of registration and average credit count in building. School with higher credit count will result in more staffing.
- Board wide--declining enrolment. People are not having as many children.
- Once a student is enrolled or transfered to Westmount they can remain a Westmount student throughout their high school career.
- Administration staying the same next year.

- Literacy test March 31, 2016. There will be a modified school day. Letter was sent home.
- There was supposed to be online version this year, but not at this point. There was online prep tests. A number of students taking after school literacy classes
