
RETURNING TO WCI?



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Course Selection for Gr. 12

- Select courses you plan to complete **at Westmount.**
 - **Do not select** any course you intend to complete outside WCI (See Guidance).
- Choose courses **wisely!**
 - The WCI timetable is created based on your selections!
- **It is not about leaving doors open.**
 - It is about taking courses required for post secondary programs - Do your research!
 - It is about taking courses you do well in.



Grade 12 Full-time Status

- We only have **full time** students at WCI.
 - Part-time students are not permitted.
- In Grade 12 you must have a **minimum** of 3 courses **each semester** – there are no exceptions!
 - We suggest you choose 7 courses.
- **After midterm** report cards are distributed, students **may drop one course** and take a minimum of 2 courses for the remainder of the semester.
 - **1 course is never allowed.**
 - Only courses you have been **attending regularly** will be permitted to drop.

 - University → **ENG4U** + **5 M or U** courses (check prereqs)
- Will you meet all graduation requirements?
 - 30 credits, 40 hours, literacy test
 - Group 1, 2 and 3 compulsory courses
- **Reflect** on your past performance.
- **Assess** your achievement and abilities.
- **Consult** with your teachers and parents.



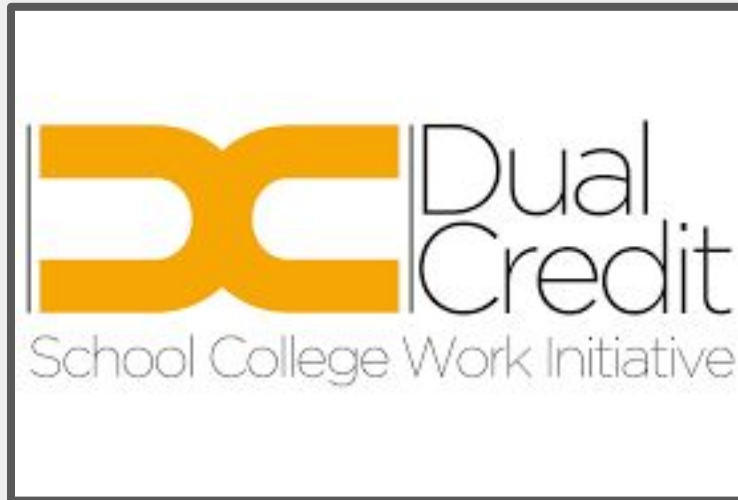
Co-operative Education

- **Application required.**
 - Select Co-op on myBlueprint then **complete the online application** which can be found on your myBlueprint.

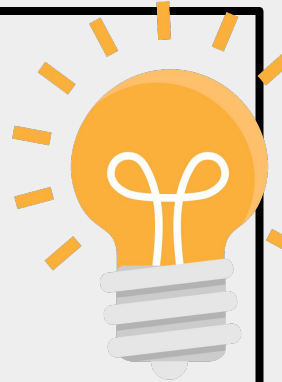
What to Consider

- **Compulsory Courses**
 - English, Math
 - C → College (NBE3C1, MBF3C1)
 - M → College/University (MCF3M1)
 - U → University (NBE3U, MCR3U1)
- Select 8 courses for Grade 11.
- ALL students must have a **FULL TIMETABLE.**
 - 4 courses each Semester
 - You **are able** to select a Grade 12 course in your selection as long as you will have the prerequisite.
 - Speak to the teachers who teach the courses you're interested in.



Other Considerations

- Group 1, 2, & 3 Compulsory Courses.
 - Dropping science after Grade 10?
 - Consider Group 3 (Tech, Co-op, a third French).
- Community Involvement Hours.
- Elective Prerequisites – Thinking Ahead – Plan Backwards
 - Check Grade 12 courses to see if there is a Grade 11 prerequisite (Tech, Computer Science/Tech, Arts, languages, Accounting)
 - For Example: TDJ4M1 (Design Tech) requires TDJ3M1.
- Have you done an Arts (art, dance, drama, music) credit?



Other Considerations

- Select Grade 11 courses you plan to complete **at Westmount.**
- **Do not select** any course you intend to complete outside WCI (See Guidance).



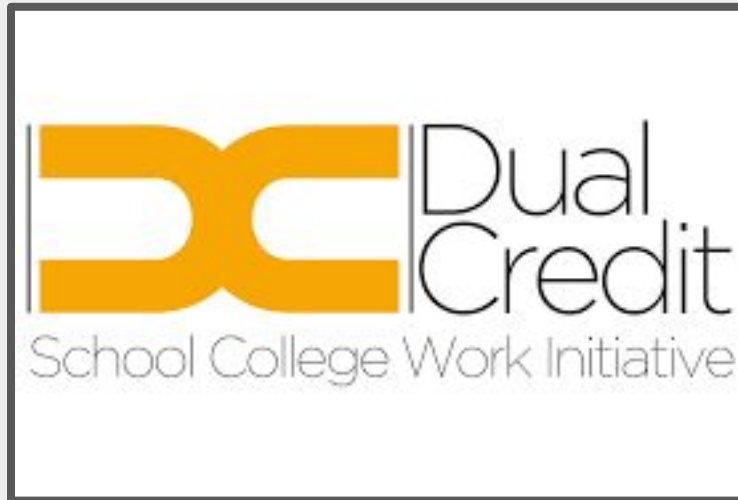
Co-operative Education
