## Principal's Report - Brad Derry

- Update on the Cost Share Program
$\checkmark \$ 4100$ to purchase 25 Chrome books, iRovers, carts and some peripheral pieces
$\checkmark$ Chrome books cost had been reduced and we were able to purchase 32 instead of 25
$\checkmark$ We were also able to get 4 more Chrome books for a total of 36 with some other school funds
- Application for 2 grants
$\checkmark$ Metro Green Apple grant - \$1000 - being used to subsidize the breakfast program, fresh fruit and Big Crunch; Sara Abdulla volunteered to purchase fresh fruit for each week
