$\checkmark$ Not considered an outbreak but the school is dealing with a few cases
$\checkmark$ If your child was affected, a letter would have been sent home to the parents
$\checkmark$ New board policy - only those students with "live" lice have been sent home
- Water bottle filling station is up and running; built-in counter that shows how many plastic water bottles we are saving
- Outreach Programs targeting grades 5 and 8
$\checkmark$ Grade 5 - Making a Difference
$\checkmark$ Grade 8 - Cyber Busters
- York Region VIP Police program for Grade 6's - Ms. Rufft to coordinate
- School Police Officer to visit with grades 3, 7 and 8 's this year - one time visit
- Lunch assistants update - still looking for assistants on Wednesdays
- Review of the EQAO data
$\checkmark$ Results above the Board and Provincial average for Grade 3 Reading, Writing and Mathematics
$\checkmark$ Results above the Board and Provincial average for Grade 6 Reading and Writing and slightly above the Provincial average in Grade 6 Mathematics;
$\checkmark$ Many discussions around math at the Board level
$\checkmark$ For the first time, all kids are getting 60 mins of math each day for all grades
$\checkmark$ Designated math lead in the school - Ms. Rufft
