## Fresh from the Farm Program

- Provides schools opportunity to raise funds by selling fresh, Ontario grown fruits and vegetables
- School gets $40 \%$ of sales
- Veggies include carrots, onions, potatoes, sweet potatoes (approx. \$13)
- $\quad 8 \mathrm{lb}$ bag of empire apples (approx. \$15)
- Volunteers required to sort and ensure orders are distributed to families
- Families to pick up orders (one time only) on agreed upon date in November
- Enrollment May 2-October 2


## Fundraising Committee - Sara Abdulla

- Committee met with Brad Derry and decided to pursue two service-based companies that provide products to parent community with limited effort
- Mabel's Labels - $20 \%$ of sales returned to school. No funds collected by school, parents order online, school makes money and parents save on fewer lost items
- Fundscrip - gift card fundraiser - parents order gift cards online, buy face value, get face value - no added cost to purchaser - unsure of fundraising percentage to be returned to school and how cards to be distributed - fundraising committee to get more info
