#### Principal's Report - Brad Derry

Regional Parent Symposium

- Mr. Derry and 3 parents from the school attended on April 4<sup>th</sup> at Sheraton Parkway in Markham
- Michelle Cassidy Mental Health Lead at YRDSB presented a session on mattering and belonging for children
- Zones of regulation self regulation program; author is Leah Kuypers; Mr Derry has slide deck if interested
- John Storie provided additional insight into Zones of Regulation as it was used in Fresh Start program helps students gain skills in consciously regulating their actions; results in increased control and problem solving; provides students with a visual cue to represent different zones; colour representation of how they're feeling; red angry/frustrated, green happy, blue sad, yellow state of escalation
