6:00 – 7:30PM All parents and guardians are welcome to attend.

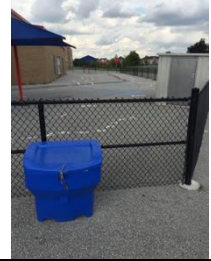


ENTRY AND DISMISSAL PROCEDURES

Morning Entry Bus Loop: Please note that our bus loop has two lanes. One lane is to drive through, and the other is for drop off. Please drive all the way to the front to drop off, to ensure that traffic is NOT backed up on Wilclay Ave.



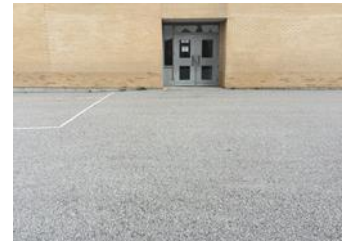
Kindergarten Pen: Please make contact with the teacher and/or DECE or Lunch time supervisor, when picking or dropping off students into/out of the pen.



Primary Doors: Grade 1 and 2 students are to enter through these doors at 8:15 am. During dismissal, parents are asked to stay back and wait for the teacher to dismiss the children.



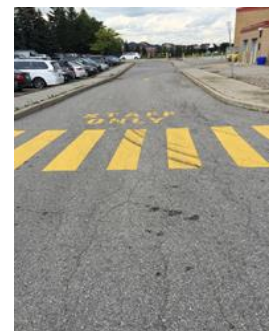
Junior Doors: Grade 3 – 6 students are to enter through these doors at 8:15am. Parents are to wait outside these doors for their children.



Intermediate Doors: Grade 7-8 enter through these doors at 8:15am.



Staff Parking Lot: The school parking lot is for Staff Only. Please do not enter the parking lot to pick your children up. You may park on the side streets and walk to the school. Please note that parking on Wilclay Ave. is prohibited.



ELECTRONIC DEVICES AND TECHNOLOGY

During instructional time, individual teachers will have individual rules pertaining to the use of personal technology, such as iPods, iPads, iPhones, cell phones, etc. to be used for educational purposes during class time. Please check with your child's teacher as to the rules pertaining to his/her class.

Please don't send your child to school with expensive electronic equipment without first checking with your child's teacher and signing appropriate technology agreements found in the **School Start Up package**.



For safety and supervision purposes, students are **not permitted** to have MP3 players, iPods, cell phones, etc. during recesses or during lunch eating time. The school will not assume any responsibility for these valuable items.

HEALTHY SNACKS AND LUNCH

Wilclay Public School is a peanut/treenut safe school. To ensure a safe school for all, parents are asked NOT to send food containing peanuts/treenuts and related products to school with their children. At Wilclay, we also stay away from products such as Wow Butter, that look like peanut butter.

Students are encouraged to prepare their snacks/lunch from the night before with their parents. There is a greater likelihood of them eating their snack/lunch when they have prepared it themselves.



SAFE ARRIVAL PROGRAM

If your child is going to be late or absent, please call the school and let us know at (905)470-1447. If we do not receive a message on our machine or telephone call in the morning, we will follow the procedure below...

Step One: Call the student's home. If there is no answer the school will,

Step Two: Call the parents at work and/or any other provided number. If there is no response the school will,

Step Three: Call the emergency contact person. If the contact person cannot be reached and/or does not know where the student is then,

Step Four: The school will notify the York Regional Police that a child is missing.

Please remember to call the school if your child will be late or absent.

YORK REGIONAL POLICE

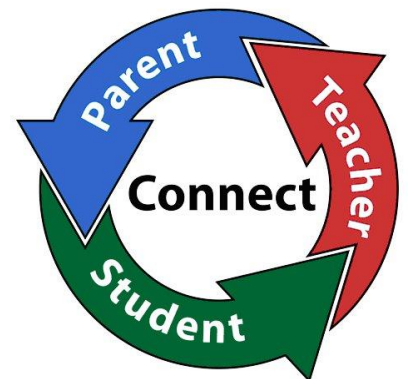

This program provides any child with the opportunity to read, write and speak a new language or maintain heritage language and culture.

DURATION

Classes operate once a week for 2.5 hours for 30 sessions from September to June.

ELIGIBILITY

Elementary school-age children, grades SK to 8 Students must be age 5 before December 31, 2017. Proof of age required.

FEE

Free program funded by the Ontario Ministry of Education. A \$10 non-refundable, consumable fee is due at registration, additional book fees may apply and will be collected during the first few weeks of classes. Cheques must be made payable to York Region District School Board. Visa students are required to pay an additional \$200 for registration.

REGISTRATION

Continuous registration available at language site during class hours until January 31, 2018. To register parents must bring their child's OEN & YRDSB student number (if YRDSB student). Both numbers can be found on the day school report card. All non-YRDSB students must provide Proof of Status in Canada (Canadian citizens require one original Citizenship/Immigration document; Other Citizenship requires two) and complete a Pupil Eligibility Attestation Form.
