1. Review and approval

• Review the Minutes from Apr.25, 2018 meeting:

- The Minutes from Apr.25, 2018 School Council meeting were approved by attendants at the meeting
- The "Great Year of Review" presentation by Ms Lindsey Rhamey and Mr. Alex Pasta. This
 presentation summarized the highlighted events, and new initiatives during 2017-2018 school
 year, which is a wonderful year overall.
 - Reached the Education Enrichment donation as \$26,812.42 (not meeting the \$35000 goal)
 - o Able to pay Scientist in the School for all grades incl. kindergarten
 - Able to purchase DreamBox Learning to strengthen the math education for all grades. In total, 14,643 lessons being completed
 - o Able to financially support AUSSIE X group come in to have a 4-day program for each class
 - In the technical part, the school was able to purchase 35 new laptops, 3 new projectors, and other new materials (e.g. Robots) to support tech. education. Financial support is half from school funding, half from Education Enrichment donations
 - Mathletes our school received the highest score among all schools being participated.
 Students feel it is very interesting
 - Able to take the whole school to visit Varley Art Gallery
 - o Able to pay for the visitation to Flato Markham Theatre for up to Grade 3 students
 - Also had grade 1 & 2 students to visit local community helpers: community centre,
 Hospital, and Fire Department
 - The Chapter's Night happened in April was a big success: it received \$1012 gift cards. All
 of the proceeds were used to support the school's learning commons
 - O Movie Night turned out well the \$800 income was used to support school's Art Program (Paint a Smile and a new drum kit for music program)
 - Able to organize the overnight trip to Muskoka and Quebec City for Grade 7 & 8 students
 - o **Healthy Snacks** is loved by the students and staff all over the school
 - Markham Mayor invited our school to kick off 2018 Home Town Hockey
 - Pizza Day: Pizza Day was increased from once a month to once a week, and was like by all groups parents, students, teachers. Great appreciation to the volunteer team for persistently providing support to ensure the success of this program

 Other highlights include: the new school song, Berczy's 50th celebration, Walking Wednesdays, Valentine's Dance, Extra-curricular activities, Presentation at Quest Conference, Visitation to Netherlands, Well-Being Expo, etc.
