January 27, 2024

International Holocaust Remembrance Day

January 27, 2024 is International Holocaust Remembrance Day. This date was designated by resolution of the United Nations General Assembly in November 2005.

The day reaffirms "that the Holocaust, which resulted in the murder of one third of the Jewish people along with countless members of other minorities, will forever be a warning to all people of the dangers of hatred, bigotry, racism and prejudice" (UN General Assembly A/60/L.12).

This day serves as an international memorial day for the victims of the Nazi Holocaust, which saw the murder of 6 million Jews, 250,000 to 500,000 Roma people, 200,000 to 250,000 persons with disabilities, and 15,000 people who were LGBTQ+. January 27 marks the date when the Nazi concentration and extermination camp of Auschwitz-Birkenau was liberated by Soviet troops in 1945.

- <u>Cedarway Therapy</u>: trained and experienced clinicians from diverse backgrounds, speaking different languages (English, French, Arabic, Urdu, Gujarati, Hindi, Punjabi), and offering culturally and spiritually responsive services.
- <u>Naseeha</u>: provides an anonymous, non-judgmental, confidential and toll-free peer support helpline for youth experiencing personal challenges. Naseeha's services are open to all regardless of age, race, ethnicity, sexual orientation, gender identity, family makeup, social status, income, ability, physical and mental health, and religion.

Grade 1 French Immersion Registration for 2024-2025



Welcome to 2024-2025 grade 1 students!



Registration will take place from January 19 - February 5, 2024.

An in-person information session will be offered at Windham Ridge PS on January 18, 2024 at 7 p.m.

Registration is not first-come, first-served. Late registrations are those submitted after February 5, 2024. Late registrations will be treated on a first-come, first-served basis and will be considered subsequent to registrations received during the registration period, should overflow be necessary.

Parents/guardians of Senior Kindergarten students currently enrolled in a YRDSB school entering Grade 1 in 2024 and wishing to enroll in the FI Program:

- can email or call their home school office (where your child currently attends) and declare their intention to register in FI.
- WRPS office will contact parents by email requesting that you forward ONE piece of identification showing your address to complete the registration. (see acceptable documents below)
- Please forward your documents by email to Windham Ridge at <u>Windham.ridge.ps@yrdsb.ca</u>. See below a list of acceptable documents.

Families registering students who do not currently attend a YRDSB school will need to complete <u>full registration paperwork</u> and email it to <u>windham.ridge.ps@yrdsb.ca</u>

Information required for FULL registration includes:

- Proof of child's age (Birth Certificate/Passport)
- Any legal documents related to custody arrangements if applicable
- Proof of Residency of the student Three documents needed, ONE from Category A and TWO from Category B:

Acceptable documentation (Proof of Address):

- Three documents required.
- All documents must show home address for student living with the parent(s)/guardians(s). All documents must contain parent or guardian's name.
- One document from Category A. This document must be an original.
- Two documents required from Category B.

etc. (must be current - within past year)

Category A – one original document required

Property Tax Bill / MPAC Notice of Assessment (must be current – within past year)
Agreement of Purchase and Sale, including proof of purchase and closing date, provided before student attends school (must be current – within past year)
Bank Statement / Financial letter: must be stamped by Financial Institution (financial details can be obscured) (must be current – within two months)
Any CRA document (i.e. Notice of Assessment, Canada Child Benefit, Goods and Services Tax/Harmonized sales Tax (GST/HST credit), Housing Benefits,

Terra Cotta Cookies




Terra Cotta Cookies - Vanilla Heart Cookies
