Vaisakhi: April 14, 2023 The month of April is proclaimed as Sikh Heritage Month as per <u>The Sikh Heritage</u> Month Act of 2013.

As we begin the month of April, we are encouraged to join Canadians who will be coming together to celebrate how Sikh Canadians have made significant contributions to the growth and prosperity of Ontario and Canada's social, economic, political, and cultural fabric.

On April 1, 2021 Minister Bardish Chagger issued the following statement from Ottawa:

"Canada is proud to be home to more than 500,000 <u>Sikh Canadians</u>, making it one of the largest Sikh diasporas in the world. Since the arrival of the first Sikh immigrants in the late 19th century, members of this community have contributed to Canada through their achievements in all areas of society and have helped shape the diversity found



within it. Sikhism's core principles include equality, generosity, openness, and compassion. Sikh Heritage Month is an opportunity to reflect on the pivotal role that Sikh communities have played, and continue to play, in building a stronger and consciously more inclusive Canada."

During the month of April, Sikh Canadians celebrate Vaisakhi, which marks the

creation of the Khalsa and the Sikh articles of faith. Sikh Canadians widely celebrate Vaisakhi, also known as Khalsa Day, across Ontario.

By fostering acceptance we can build stronger and more inclusive communities and learning environments for students with Autism.

We continue to move away from raising awareness for Autism to increasing acceptance. Awareness seeks to highlight how dissimilar we are and emphasizes the differences and distance between our ways of being.
