

In education, it is critical to represent the historical and contemporary excellence of Muslims through literature, the arts, math, science, and all other areas of the curriculum as part of our unwavering commitment to equity and inclusion. Thursday October 19th is Spirit Day!	Each year, students, educators and allies bring attention to the need for safer and more inclusive learning and working environments for Two-Spirit, lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer, questioning, intersex and individuals with related identities (2SLGBTQI+). October 19 is Spirit Day, a day started in 2010 by Brittany McMillan, a Canadian teenager. Brittany created the event after learning about youth who lost their lives to suicide after experiencing bullying related to actual or perceived sexual orientation, gender identity and expression identities. It has become an annual event in October when millions of North Americans wear purple to show their support for 2SLGBTQI+ youth and take a stand against bullying. Students, schools, organizations, corporations, media professionals, celebrities, parents, and families wear purple to convey that 2SLGBTQI+ youth are to be celebrated and respected for who they are. The purple stripe on the pride flag represents spirit, giving this day its name. <b>We invite students to wear purple on Thursday October 19th!</b>

Congratulations to all of our Cross Country team members who had a great day!


All students ran with perseverance, with determination, and with Windham Ridge pride! We have many students advancing to regionals next week and we will be cheering you on from WRPS!
