


This is a painting of the Canadian prairies, a major food source: fundamental for our future."



### National Day for Truth and Reconciliation



Education is what got us into this mess, and education will get us out.

Each year, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process.



This federal statutory holiday was created through <u>legislative amendments</u> made by Parliament.

### Wear orange

Both the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation and <u>Orange Shirt Day</u> take place on September 30. We will be observing this day on September 29, 2023.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.


