

Parents/guardians received an email from YRDSB Update with important forms to complete. It is important that these forms are <u>completed as soon as possible at the start of the school year as they contain important information and permissions.</u>

Please note:

- You must be signed in to your child's student GAPPS account to complete the form. Please remember to sign out of one account before signing into another.
- The forms should be completed for each student, whether they are attending school in person or participating in remote, online learning.
- If you prefer to complete the forms on paper or have questions about the information in the forms, please contact the school office.
- Parents/guardians must complete a separate form for each child attending school. Please ensure you log out of one student account before logging into another. You will not be able to submit the form twice logged into the same student account.
- It is important that these forms are completed online as soon as possible to allow your child's participation in various activities.

We are awaiting the arrival of the 2021-2022 yearbook. As soon as it arrives at the school, it will be distributed to students in a timely manner. Thanking parents and students in advance for their patience.

Student Absences and Safe Arrival

Notify the school before 8:40 a.m. if your child is going to be absent or late for school. For your convenience, *Planned Absences* can also be entered in advance.

There are two ways to report:

1) Call the automated phone reporting system before 8:40 am by dialing 905-773-5443 and press 1, follow the prompts provided. After 8:40 am, the system will not allow you to enter the absence.

2) Report on Edsby (a mobile App is available)

Keep in mind that it is also necessary to let the office know of the absence even if you have already notified the teacher in advance.

If the office is unsuccessful in reaching parents or emergency contacts provided by parents at the beginning of the year, the school is required to call the *police* to ensure the safety and location of the student.

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

National Day for Truth and Reconciliation



The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process.

Orange Shirt Day is an Indigenous-led grassroots commemorative day intended to raise awareness of the individual, family and community inter-generational impacts of residential schools, and to promote the concept of "Every Child Matters". The orange shirt is a symbol of the stripping away of culture, freedom and self-esteem experienced by Indigenous children over generations.
