Families are invited to attend our 2022-2023 Curriculum Night on Thursday October 6, 2022.

Curriculum Night is an opportunity to see your child's classroom, meet the teacher(s), and gain insight into the grade curriculum, classroom routines, and communication systems used with your child's teacher(s).

As it is early on in the school year, staff is in the process of collecting information about your child. Staff will not be able to provide you an update on your child's development during Curriculum Night. You are encouraged to reach out to your child's teacher to set a time to discuss your questions or concerns before or after October 6th.

Parents/Guardians are not required to register for Curriculum Night. A gentle reminder that if your child(ren) will be accompanying you to Curriculum Night, there is no child minding available and your child(ren) will need to remain with you for the duration of your visit. There will be two repeated sessions to allow families with siblings to attend more than one presentation.

Each year, September 30 marks the National Day for Truth and Reconciliation.

The day honours the children who never returned home and Survivors of residential schools, as well as their families and communities. Public commemoration of the tragic and painful history and ongoing impacts of residential schools is a vital component of the reconciliation process.



This federal statutory holiday was created through <u>legislative amendments</u> made by Parliament.

On September 30th at Windham Ridge PS, students continued their learning about the history of residential schools through age-appropriate resources and lessons in their classes.



During our virtual morning announcements, we all viewed the story <u>"You Hold Me Up"</u> by Monique Gray Smith and reflected on responsibilities to support one another.

we take note of our actions and change our actions to show our commitment to Truth and Reconciliation.


The office has sent out Student Registration Verification Forms.
