		Conference topics include: Family life, student confidence, Math
		Speaker: Anne Kidder "People for Education"
		Cell phone discussion: school is looking for parent input on the use of cell phones in our school in preparation for new school policy – currently different teacher approaches exist
		Parents and teachers both note the distractions caused during instruction time
		Often IEP can benefit from the use of cell phones under certain circumstances – effective use is good (Athena)
		We have to be careful not to stigmatize individual students (who have IEP's) in front of their peers when only specific pupils are able to use devices if there is an all out ban (Starr)
		Several parents voice their agreement that phones should be off at all times except under direct teacher/classroom supervision
		Administration notes cell phones should also be off at recess due to the uncontrolled nature of internet content
		Action Item: ALL send criteria for cell phone in school to Starr
