| 5 | Teacher's Report | Terry Fox run raised $\$ 755.00$ this year <br> Aggie will be sending out a request to all parents for the following donations for school: <br> -Used iPods, costumes, etc. <br> -It was suggested all donations should be complete with all parts and in good working order. Bagged in clear Ziploc and labeled with all parts by family before sending in. |
| 6 | New Business | Parent Grade 8 trip input <br> -Regarding the grade 8 trip last year it was noted by administration that the "purpose" of any trip was to be given consideration <br> -Last year there was extensive consultation with School Council regarding overnight trips <br> -A behavior contract was completed with council consult as well as Technology Agreement <br> -New School Board trip policy 642.2 was discussed last year with council <br> Parents posed the question to our administration why has the "French component as the purpose" been removed from the Grade 8 overnight trip? Why were parents not consulted on location/purpose change per the principal's report done last year? <br> School Principal Veronique noted the following items were considered in choice trip/venue: <br> -New board policy 642.2 adherence (this is the first year a trip has been planned under the new policy) |


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|  | -Overnight trip is the sole responsibility of the Principal in consultation with Staff. Parent input is then sought regarding, cost, timing and expectations. <br> -"Health \& Safety" has become the most important component of any overnight trip. A controlled environment is needed to ensure student safety <br> -Teachers must first agree to participate and abide by all responsibilities of 642.2 ( 41 item checklist) in order for a trip to be considered <br> -With this leadership role comes great responsibility for the teachers <br> -Teachers choose to participate on a voluntary basis <br> -Staff will come up with proposed trip ideas and/or trip option <br> -Our teachers felt the option they would be most comfortable with pursuing would be a Northern Retreat location rather than a city location and hotel where students would not have constant supervision <br> -Northern retreat location would provide parent access to their child, within 2 hours, for whatever reason <br> -Two locations were investigated by participating teachers and date was flexible <br> -Parent/student budget was also given consideration with retreat being the more economical choice <br> -Parent information night will follow in spring regarding venue particulars with representatives of chosen venue in attendance <br> -Students have been positive about this venue and the overnight component with friends etc. <br> -Spring may also include Grade 8 trip to Toronto for French Theatre and French restaurant outing |
