- occupational health & safety;
- student safety and violent incident prevention;
- training on supporting student mental health and well-being; and
- understanding cybersecurity and online privacy.

Topic 2: Literacy/Mathematics Instructional Strategies

Entity Hosting: All Elementary Schools

Presenter(s)/Facilitator(s): Online modules developed by Board staff, self-directed and/or group-directed in grade/division groupings.

Description: Literacy: Kindergarten to Grade 8 educators will participate in a module

providing an overview of literacy in YRDSB, an orientation to the new Ontario Language curriculum, Early and Emergent Reading Instruction, Universal Design for Learning, Equitable Assessment, and Screening Tool information. **Math:** Kindergarten to Grade 8 educators will participate in a module on the nine High

Impact Instructional Practices identified by the Ministry of Education and their connection to our board's Comprehensive Math Program.
