

How to booking an appointment with your Guidance Counsellor

Student View

Here's what the students see when they log in to *teachassist*, and change their booking date to the evening of Parent/Teacher interviews. When they switch their date to the day of the Parent/Teacher Interviews, they'll be presented with a list of teachers and available time slots. They can book more than one slot, so you'll have to check from time to time to see if that is the case and cancel out appointments where necessary.

2 credits in Science

1 credit in Technological Education (**Grade 9 or Grade 10) NEW**

1 credit in Canadian History (**Grade 10**)

1 credit in Canadian Geography (**Grade 9**)

1 credit in the Arts

1 credit in Health and Physical Education

1 credit in French as a second language

0.5 credit in Career Studies

0.5 credit in Civics and Citizenship

1 credit from the [STEM-related course group](#)

13 Optional Credits

- You must earn 13 optional credits by successfully completing courses from your school's program and course calendar
- Optional credits may include up to 4 credits Dual Credits

STEM-related course group

Of the 17 compulsory credits, you must complete **ONE** from the following group:

- Business studies
- Computer studies
- Cooperative education
- Mathematics (in addition to the 3 compulsory credits currently required)
- Science (in addition to the 2 compulsory credits currently required)
- Technological education (in addition to the 1 compulsory credit required)
