The board will pay the remaining \$2143.47. We can purchase more technology through round 2 of Cost-Sharing. The Board and school can purchase an additional \$9314.80
					collectively for more technology (\$3725.92 would be the school's portion). We have held off on Round 2 while we consider other initiatives that require money – scientist in the school, graduations at the end of the year-but would like to take advantage if Round 2 this spring.
					In September we will have grade 3 FI classes. We need to buy additional desks, furniture, books for FI, which the School budget will have to cover.
